### Souray, Laxman conflict verdicts likely on Sachin's line: BCCI

**NEW DELHI:** With the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) Ombudsman D K Jain dismissing charges of conflict against Sachin Tendulkar, board officials believe the same course of action is likely in the cases of the two other members of the Cricket Advisory Committee (CAC) — Sourav Ganguly and VVS Laxman. The three had been questioned for holding positions in the CAC as well as working with IPL franchises

While Madhya Pradesh Cricket Association life member Sanjeev Gupta had raised questions of conflict against Tendulkar and Laxman, Ganguly's position was brought to Jain's notice by Bengal-based cricket fans — Bhaswati Shantua, Abhijeet Mukherjee and Ranjit Seal. A senior BCCI official said that not just Tendulkar, none of the CAC members were given terms of reference by the Committee of Administrators (CoA).

So, it was likely that both Laxman and Ganguly would also be freed of any charges of conflict. "No terms of reference were ever communicated to any of the members of the CAC by the CoA and therefore on this set of facts the verdict regarding the others is also likely to be same as Sachin's verdict," the official said.

"He has requested this repeatedly and several times over the years including as recently as December 7, 2018. While Jain is yet to give his verdict with regards to Laxman and Ganguly, in Tendulkar's case, the ombudsman wrote: "In my view, in the light of the afore extracted statement made on behalf of Sachin Tendulkar, (...) the issue of whether there is any 'conflict of interest' on part of Tendulkar does not arrive and the ethics officer need not go into the said allegation." Laxman had also hinted at the lack of clarity from the CoA with regards to the functioning of the CAC in his letter to Jain. "On December 7, 2018, we had written to the Committee of Administrators requesting them to clarify the scope of our role and responsibilities. यह मन्दिर वास्तव में सिरपुर के अवशेषों की सामग्री से ही बना प्रतीत होता है। सिरपुर से बौद्धकालीन अनेक मूर्तियां भी मिली हैं। टीला पंचायतन शिव मंदिर का उत्खनन साल 2006 में इतिहासकार अरूण शर्मा के मार्गदर्शन में किया गया। कई

पेडों से लिपट कर उन्हें सखा देने वाली कांटेदार चिल्हाटी बेल को काटकर बेचने की अनमति वन विभाग ने ग्रामीणों को दे दीँ है। इसके चलते दर्जनों ग्रामीण जंगलों में पेडों से लिपटी चिल्हाटी बेल को काट तथा उसकी छाल उतार कर 30 रुपए की दर से आंध्रप्रदेश के व्यापारियों के पास बेचने लगे हैं।

इससे जहां हजारों पेड़ सुखने से बच रहे हैं, वहीं ग्रामीणों को अतिरिक्त आय भी होने लगी है। बस्तर के जंगलों में चिल्हाटी नामक बेल की अधिकता है। इसका अंग्रेजी नाम 'क्लाइबिंग वाटली फॉर फैदर आसिया' है। ग्रामीण इसे चीलबेल के नाम से जानते हैं। यह पेड़ों को मजबृती से जकड लेती है और



सुखा देती है, वहीं इसके चलते ग्रामीणों को जंगल से वनोपज एकत्र करने में भी परेशानी होती है. इसलिए वन विभाग ने ग्रामीणों को इस बेल को काट कर बेचने की छट दे रखी है। पुसपाल, धनियालुर, कुरंदी, चिलकुटी, कावापाल आदि गांवों के ग्रामीणों ने बताया कि चील की बेल में कांटे होते हैं। इसकी छाल को काटते समय काफी सावधानी रखनी पड़ती हैं, चूंकि आंख में रस पडने पर काफी जलन होती है इसलिए चश्मा लगाकर छाल

उतारना पड़ता है। यह छाल आंध्रप्रदेश के व्यापारी दो साल से वनांचल के ग्रामीणों से खरीद रहे हैं। गीली छाल 30 रुपए प्रति किलो की दर से खरीदा जा रहा है। बताया गया कि चील छाल का उपयोग शैम्प के अलावा विभिन्न दवाइयां बनाने में होता है। इस संबंध में वन अधिकारियों का कहना है कि चिल्हाटी बेल के कारण हर प्रकार के वक्ष असमय सख जाते हैं। इससे विभाग को आर्थिक नकसान होता है, इसे काटने पर प्रतिबंध नहीं है।
